



## Course Summary

The ICAO Competency Assessor course prepares qualified Air Traffic Controllers for conducting assessments and examinations of competency amongst students for initial ATC qualifications and qualified Air Traffic Controllers pursuing individual ratings.

This course is conducted by experienced and rated Competency Assessors and encompasses current ICAO training philosophies.

Candidates will undergo theoretical classroom and practical (simulated) exercises. Practical sessions will be conducted at Global ATS' international campus using Micro Nav's BEST Simulators, utilising generic Aerodrome, Approach, and Area Control scenarios.
