Who Is This Course For?

Candidates undertaking the Ab Initio Course must demonstrate that they meet the following entry criteria:

- Hold a valid Class 3 Medical issued by an approved Aviation Medical Examiner (AME)
- A minimum of ICAO Level 4 English Language Proficiency
- Be at least 18 years old at the time of course completion
- Hold educational qualifications that would enable access to university or an equivalent educational institution
